1º) The Person

CATALINA MARTI, wife of Pedro Reus Morro (1886 – 1942), known under the name Pere Seda, who was farmer, winemaker and mayor of Binissalem between 1905 and 1910. Together they had 13 children, of whom 7 followed the winemaking tradition over Mallorca even reaching to Chile, where Llorenç Reus Martí founded Viña Santa Catalina in Santiago in 1922, a winery that today continues its activity successfully (www.santacatalina.cl).

At the beginning of the 70s of the last century, the descendants of CATALINA MARTI, who had continued their activity separately, decided to unite and founded the embryo of what is currently Pere Seda (www.pereseda.com).

The current Pere Seda industry in Manacor was started by Guillem Reus Marti in 1.925. Since then, Pere Seda has been working without interruption in the same place, being today the oldest winery in Mallorca.

Without a doubt, Pere Seda is a winery with a lot of history. But it is even more true that if it had not been for CATALINA MARTÍ, the ancestor of all of us, none of these wineries would have existed. Hence our recognition and tribute.

2º) The wine.

This new wine was born on the initiative of the female members – and women of the members of Pere Seda with the desire to design a white wine.

This initiative arose at the beginning of 2,022 at a lunch where this idea was raised.

It is a wine designed at the beginning of each year from the different white wine deposits that we have in the winery. The best blend is chosen by majority and a small batch of about 1,000 bottles is made.
